Applications are available at the Sheet Metal Workers' Local #83 office, 718900 Commerce , NY, from 8 AM to Noon and from 12:30 PM to 4:00 PM every Monday (excluding holidays).

The following are the minimum requirements of the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee.

- Be at least 18 years old.
- Have a high school or general equivalency diploma with a passing grade in algebra, math I, or at least a 47 on the GED math test.
- Take reading and arithmetic achievement tests as well as other pre-employment testing.
- Have lived within the Local's geographic jurisdiction for at least six month prior to applying – which include the following counties: Albany, Clinton, Columbia, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Hamilton, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren and Washington.
- Have a valid New York State Drivers License – Apprentices may be required to drive company vehicles.
- Have a reliable means of transportation to and from work sites and apprentice school.
- Sign an affidavit stating that they are physically able to do the work required.
- Submit to drug screening and background check at the Committee's expense – if selected for the program.

For further information, applicants should contact the New York State Department of Labor office located nearest their home.

State Law, sponsors of programs cannot discriminate against applicants because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, sex, disability or martial status.

Women and minorities are encouraged to submit applications for apprenticeship programs. Sponsors of programs are required to adopt affirmative action plans for the recruitment of women and minorities.
